

Summer I 2019 Drop/Withdrawal Refund Schedule

Drops (Continued Enrollment)

Any student who drops courses within the first four (4) days of a Summer term and remains enrolled in the University will receive refunds applicable to tuition and fees paid for those courses.

On or before the fourth class day	On or before Thursday, June 06, 2019	100%
After the fourth class day	After Thursday, June 06, 2019	0%

Withdrawals (Discontinued Enrollment)

Any student who officially withdraws from the University will receive a refund calculated according to the following percentage schedule:

Prior to the first class day	Before Monday, June 3, 2019	100%
During the first, second, or third class day	On or before Wednesday, June 5, 2019	80%
During the fourth, fifth, or sixth class day	On or before Tuesday, June 11, 2019	50%
On the seventh class day and thereafter	On or after Wednesday, June 12, 2019	0%

Refundable fees include tuition and designated tuition only.

REGULATIONS GOVERNING REFUNDS

Refunds are granted for those fees designated as "refundable". The refundable fees assessed at registration are tuition and the designated tuition fee. These fees are calculated based upon the number of semester credit hours for which a student registers. Refunds of refundable fees are calculated based upon the total amount of fees assessed at registration and not on the basis of the amount of the payment, if a student is paying on an installment basis.

DROPPED COURSES

Any student who drops courses within the first twelve (12) days of a Fall or Spring semester or within the first four (4) days of a Summer term and remains enrolled in the University will receive refunds applicable to tuition paid for those courses.

WITHDRAWAL

Any student who officially withdraws from the University will receive a prorated refund of applicable fees according to a pre-defined percentage schedule.

Students who register for courses that are paid for directly through the use of financial aid /assistance are considered enrolled at the University until they officially withdraw through the Office of the University Registrar. **Ceasing to attend classes or stopping payment of checks for fees owed without officially withdrawing from the University will result in semester grades of "F". Thus, any remaining balance owed to the University by a student who ceases to attend classes, but who does not officially withdraw through the Office of the Registrar, is still due and NOT subject to reduction.**

Any student who officially withdraws from the University will receive a refund calculated according to the following percentage schedule:

Prior to the first class day	Before Monday, July 8, 2019	100%
During the first, second, or third class day	On or before Wednesday, July 10, 2019	80%
During the fourth, fifth, or sixth class day	On or before Tuesday, July 16, 2019	50%
On the seventh class day and thereafter	On or after Wednesday, July 17, 2019	0%

Refundable fees include tuition and designated tuition only.

Prior to the first class day	Before Monday, August 26, 2019	100%
During the first class week	On or before Friday, August 30, 2019	80%
During the second class week	On or before Friday, September 6, 2019	70%
During the third class week	On or before Friday, September 13, 2019	50%
During the fourth class week	On or before Friday, September 20, 2019	25%
After the fourth class week	After Friday, September 20, 2019	0%

Prior to the first class day	Before Tuesday, January 21, 2020	100%
During the first class week	On or before Friday January 24, 2020	80%
During the second class week	On or before Friday, January 31, 2020	70%
During the third class week	On or before Friday, February 7, 2020	50%
During the fourth class week	On or before Friday, February 14, 2020	25%
After the fourth class week	After Friday, February 14, 2020	0%
