The Educational Opportunity

Center (EOC) is a federally funded grant program sponsored by the

US Department of Education. The goal of the EOC program is to encourage low-income,

underrepresented individuals to pursue heir educational studies beyond high school and to provide assistance and counseling to those individuals

Am I Eligible?

In order to qualify for EOC program services, you must meet all of the following requirements:

- Are at least 19 years of age or 18 and not being served by a Talent Search program
- Is a citizen, national or permanent resident of the United States, or is in the United States for other than a temporary purpose and are able to provide evidence from Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) of your intent to become a permanent resident
- Must reside in one of the following counties: Austin, Brazoria, Chambers, Colorado, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Liberty, Matagorda, Montgomery, Waller, Walker, or Wharton
- Expresses a desire to enroll or is enrolled in an educational, vocational, or other job training program past the high school/GED level
