

MEMBERSHIP INTAKE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Effective: Spring 2020

National Pan-Hellenic Council organizations/ Non-National Pan-Hellenic Council organizations:

- Prospective candidates must attend the Risk Management Workshop/Greek
 Informational (attendance must be documented)
- Prospective candidates must be free of disciplinary action (probation, investigation, etc.)
- Prospective candidates must have completed twenty-four (24) credit hours (accepted by TSU) Transfer students must have earned 12 credit hours of the 24 hours required from TSU.
- Prospective candidates must have the national grade point average (GPA) required by the organization
- Prospective candidates must have earned their last twelve (12) credit hours at TSU
- Prospective candidates must be currently enrolled as a full-time student/twelve (12) credit hours

Please note: TSU's minimum requirements take priority over the local, regional, & national organization's requirements
