

# Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0 (TSIA2), formerly called TSI Exemption Rules

## ACT or SAT EXEMPTIONS

**SCORES CAN BE NO MOR THAN FIVE (5) YEARS OLD**

## TAKS EXEMPTION

**SCORES CAN BE NO MORE THAN FIVE (5) YEARS OLD**

Eleventh grade exit – level TAKS Scores of 2200 or higher in Math and / or 2200 or higher in English Language Arts with a Writing Composition rating of 3 or higher.

**\*The English Language Arts and Writing Composition sections must be met together\***

If neither or only one area is met, the student must take both Reading and Writing sections of the TSIA2.

## STAAR EXEMPTION

STAAR End-of-Course (EOC) with a Level 2 score or higher on the English III Section

**\*TSIA2 READING & WRITING EXEMPT\***

STAAR End-of-Course (EOC) with a Level 2 pr higher on Algebra II Section

## EXISTING COLLEGE DEGREE EXEMPTION

**\*TSIA2 MATH EXEMPT\***

If a student has earned an associate or bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university.

## TEXAS COLLEGE BRIDGE EXEMPTION

The Texas College Bridge (TCB) Certification program is a partnership with the Texas Education Agency and The NROC Project. High School juniors and seniors are allowed to take the college prep courses to help ensure they are college – ready. Students scoring a 90 or higher are issued a Certificate that qualifies them to be exempt from TSIA2.

Students must submit their TCB Certificates via GreenLightLocker for verification:

- If you have Language Arts and Math Certificates, you will have to send separately.

**\* TCB Certificates will not qualify for exemption after 2 years from graduation\***

## MILITARY EXEMPTION

### Military Service:

1. Students who are Active-duty members of the United States Armed Forces or Texas National Guard will be exempted. Official documentation of active-duty status for the enrollment period is required. Students must file a Verification of Active Duty form each semester which can be obtained in the Base Education Office.
2. Students who are members of a reserve component of the armed forces for at least three (3) years preceding enrollment.
3. Students who on or after August 1, 1990, with and honorable discharge, retirement or release from active duty as a member of the United States Armed Forces, Texas National Guard, or member of reserve component will be exempted. A copy of the DD214 form showing this status is required.

## TRANSFER STUDENT EXEMPTION

Students who are transferring to Texas Southern University (TSU) from a private and or out-of-state, regionally – accredited college or university, may meet sections of the TSIA2 based on the grade of a C or higher in courses that are equivalent to the following TSU courses:

### Writing\*

- Freshman English I & II: ENG 131 or ENG 132

### Reading\*

- English Literature: 230, 231, 235, & 244 (World, American & African American)
- United States History: HIST 231 or 232
- American Government: POLS 235 or 236
- General Psychology: PSY 131

### Mathematics\*

- College Algebra or any Higher-Level Math: MATH 133

**\*\*\*TAKS, STAAR, and all Transcripts need to submit to Admissions@Tsu.Edu for exemption clearance. Military Exemptions and Texas College Bridge Certificates (use method above) need to be submitted to TSI@Tsu.Edu for exemption clearance. \*\*\***
